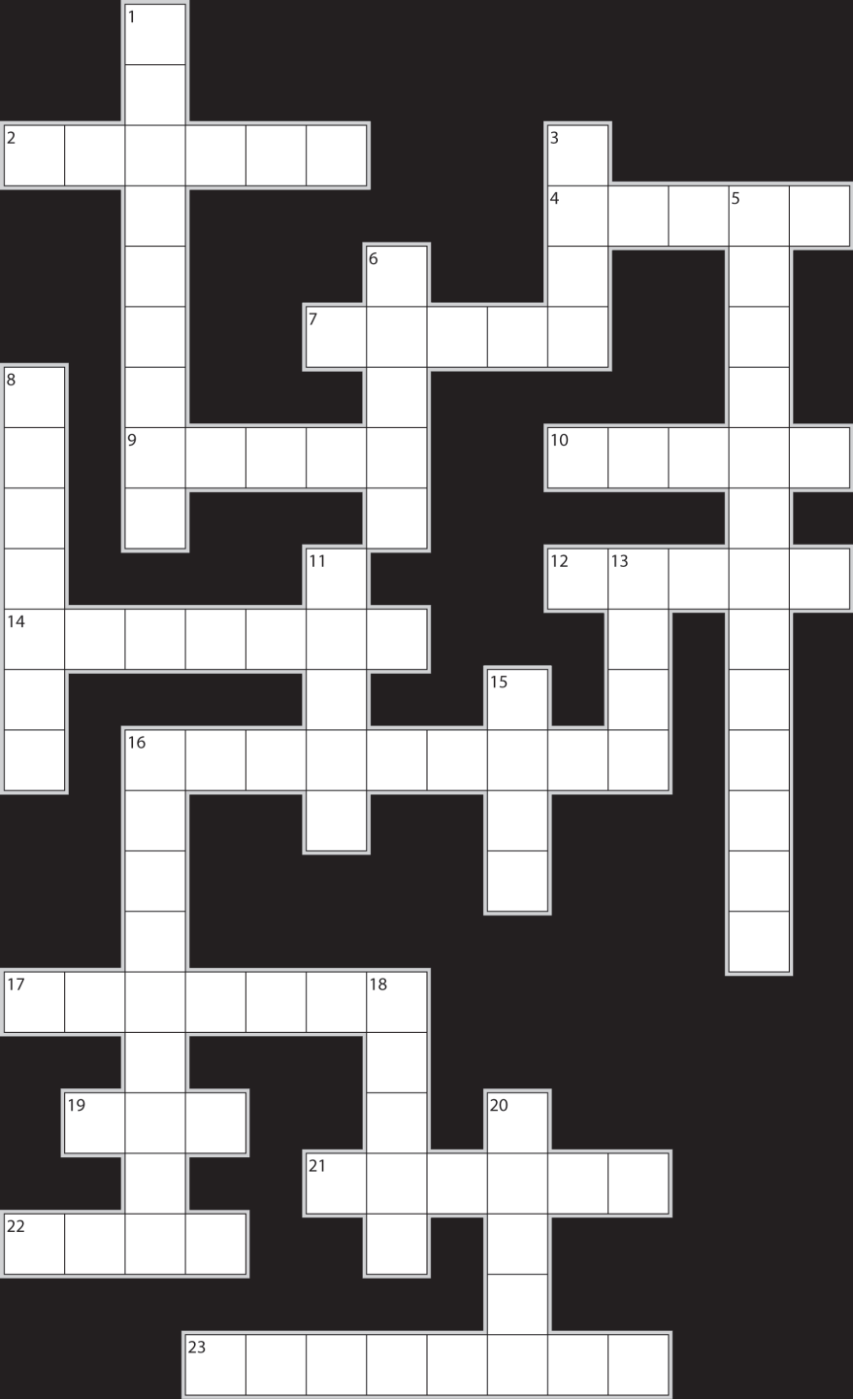
Feed the Hunger
